Change Log

Modifications to the November 2012 RCDP Memorialized in the Final Revised May 2013 RCDP

1. Cover page: Date of Final RCDP changed from “November 2012” to “Revised May 2013”.
2. Updated pagination for Section 7.7 of the Table of Contents and inserted Appendix M. Responsiveness Summary to RCDP
3. Page ES-2, Para 1, Fourth Sentence: Changed “approximately \$16.7 million” to “approximately \$16.6 million”.
4. Page ES-4, Para 2, Fourth Sentence, “*These properties will be deeded to the State of New York to become part of the Coles Creek State Park and Wilson Hill Wildlife Management Area, respectively.*”: The sentence was modified to read “These properties will be deeded to the State of New York to become part of the Wilson Hill Wildlife Management Area.” The NYSDEC decided the Coles Creek parcel would be a better fit for the Wilson Hill Wildlife Management Area than for the Coles Creek State Park.
5. Page ES-4, Para 2, Sixth Sentence, “*The total value of the settlement is still undetermined. Potential projects providing the remaining ecological compensation are discussed in Section 5.5.*”: Changed to read “The sale of stock provided the Trustees with approximately \$1.84 million for restoration projects after reimbursing the Trustees for past assessment costs. Preferred projects...”
6. Page ES-4, Para 2, Seventh Sentence, “*Potential projects providing the remaining ecological compensation are discussed in Section 5.5 but will be identified once funds from the GM settlement become available.*”: Changed “Potential” to Preferred” so the sentence now reads, “*Preferred projects providing the remaining ecological compensation are discussed in Section 5.5.*”.
7. Page ES-5, Para 3, First Sentence, “*As described in the Alcoa Consent Decree, as compensation for lost recreational fishing trips Alcoa will undertake, at the direction of the Trustees, a suite of five restoration projects that together will provide sufficient, additional (i.e., above and beyond baseline) recreational fishing opportunities of appropriate type and quality.*”: Modify to read “...as compensation for lost recreational fishing trips from the Alcoa and Reynolds sites, Some of GM settlement funds may be used for a sixth recreational fishing access project in or adjacent to Akwesasne.”
8. Page 5-6, Section 5.5, Para 3: Appended “Additional projects will be identified in the future that will be funded from the GM bankruptcy settlement.”
9. Page 7-5, Top Para: The following sentence was inserted: “The Trustees will also evaluate whether to use some of GM settlement funds for a sixth recreational fishing access project in or adjacent to Akwesasne.”
10. A Responsiveness Summary for the RCDP public comment period has been appended to the Revised May 2013 RCDP as Appendix M.
