Alcoa, in cooperation with the Town of Madrid, plans to construct a recreational fishing area on the Grass River for public use. The construction is part of a consent decree settlement between Alcoa and NOAA, DOI, NYSDEC, USFWS, USFWS and the St. Regis Mohawk Tribe who serve as Trustees for natural resources under the consent decree. A recreational fishing assessment performed jointly by Alcoa and the Trustees determined that construction of updated and improved recreational boating facilities such as depicted below will compensate the public for lost recreational fishing opportunities due to fish advisories posted in
