

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING COMMENTS ON THE
ALCOA/REYNOLDS NRDA SETTLEMENT CONSENT DECREE

1. This is your opportunity to provide comments on the Alcoa/Reynolds natural resource damage settlement Consent Decree (CD).
2. On March 27, 2013, the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) lodged a CD with the United States District Court for the Northern District of New York. The CD summarizes the provisions of the natural resource damage settlement between the St. Lawrence Trustees, Alcoa Inc. and Reynolds Metal Company. There are several attachments to the CD including the Restoration and Compensation Determination Plan (RCDP) for the St. Lawrence Environment.
